**10:55 a.m.** – Sunday School Teachers meet/greet children in Large Vestry.

**11:00 a.m.** – Kindergarten Children go directly to their classroom (Room #11). Children (Grade 1 to Grade 5) participate in first 10 minutes of worship service upstairs.

**11:10 a.m.** – Sunday School Teachers take children downstairs to their respective classrooms.

**12:10 p.m.** – Sunday School concludes – Children K to Grade 5 taken to Large Vestry for dismissal and sign-out by parent/guardian.

<sup>17</sup>Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. <sup>18</sup>And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.
