MINISTRIES FOR CHILDREN SUNDAY MORNING 9:30 A.M. to 12:10 P.M.

Parents may take children ages infant to age 4 directly to their classrooms to be signed in.

Nursery in Room #3 (downstairs) for infants and 1 year olds.

Toddlers in Room #15 (downstairs) for children 2 years old.

Beginners in Room #14 (downstairs) for children 3-4 years old.

Parents, please take children Kindergarten to Gr. 5 to the **Large Vestry** (downstairs) to be "signed in" before the 9:30a.m. or 11:00a.m. service. Children will then participate in the Worship Service (upstairs) and will be taken downstairs by leaders for age appropriate Worship following the schedule below.

- 9:30 a.m.** – K to Grade 5 children will be part of the Worship Service and may sit with their parents or leaders
- 9:40 a.m.** – K to Grade 5 children will leave sanctuary with leaders to go to their worship area in the Large Vestry.
- 10:40 a.m.** – Transition time begins in Large Vestry (Any children leaving must be "signed out". Any children arriving must be "signed in".)
- 10:55 a.m.** – Sunday School Teachers meet/greet children in Large Vestry.
- 11:00 a.m.** – Kindergarten Children go directly to their classroom (Room #11). Children (Grade 1 to Grade 5) participate in first 10 minutes of worship service upstairs.
- 11:10 a.m.** – Sunday School Teachers take children downstairs to their respective classroom.
- 12:10 p.m.** – Sunday School concludes – Children K to Grade 5 taken to Large Vestry for dismissal and sign-out by parent/guardian.
