Refugee Family # 2 June 2010 Update

As you are aware Canada Immigration has refused Brenda and family as Refugees to Canada and we, as a church, assisted them in leaving the Refugee Camp in Ghana and returning to their own country, Liberia, in December 2009.

In January 2010, we learned that Brenda and her family had moved from Gbanga, Liberia to Monrovia, Liberia after finding a brother alive in Monrovia. Brenda has enrolled the children in a school there.

We are glad she has found family (she is living with a brother in a one bedroom accommodation in Monrovia) but we feel uncertain at times about her current situation and needs as it is difficult to communicate with her either by phone or email. As a Newcomer Committee we did send Brenda money for the children to be enrolled in school for a semester, as we promised her, on behalf of our church family. *Receipts were received for the children's' registration, tuition and uniforms from Grace Baptist Institute, Lulu Pennoh Community, Barnersville, Liberia as of Jan 19, 2010. Grades 5, 8 and 9*

As a committee, we would like to continue supporting the children so they can continue their education in the future in Liberia. We are currently (June 2010), waiting to receive copies of the children's Home Reports and a note from each of the 3 children, before we plan to send money for school for the next term.

Estella received a phone call last week (June 16th) from Brenda with the good news that Albertha will graduate from Grade 9 the end of June. Brenda had been concerned that the school would put her back a grade due to their move from Ghana to Liberia, but Albertha is a good student and has done very well indeed. Benjamin and Blessing are doing well in school too and Brenda will send us their home reports when they receive them. Brenda has recovered from a fever she has been struggling with and sounded more like herself on the phone.
