Thoughts from Pastor Roger:

The Visioning Process at FHB has given us a clear image of what we want to be. We are a church that focuses on sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ so that people can come to know Him (Conversion) and grow in Him (Transformation). We want to be a more “visible, intentional and accessible well-spring of living water” pouring out so that our community will drink and come into a relationship with Christ. Whatever our ministries might be we expect them to include Evangelism and Discipleship. This is who we are.

As we think about the task of the people of FHB we know now what we are expecting. We know how we can measure the things we are hoping to do in the next couple of years. The NCD survey (results below) has shown us that our weakest characteristic is “Need-oriented Evangelism”. This can be broken down into three areas:

- PRAY
- CARE
- SHARE

In our Visioning assessment we have already seen our objective to become more connected with our community and to care for them. We have been praying for them and must continue to do so, even increasing our opportunities to pray together. We want to share with them the message of Jesus Christ, and we are looking for opportunity to do this. Our vision tells us that the way we will get this opportunity will be by “Caring for our Community”.

We are on the journey of “continually learning about our community’s needs” and “connecting through inter-cultural, inter-generational, life-changing, Christ-like ministries” so that the Good News of Jesus Christ will turn our community from darkness to light, from death to life, and from chaos to order. We cannot make this happen but we can proactively

- PRAY
- CARE and
- SHARE

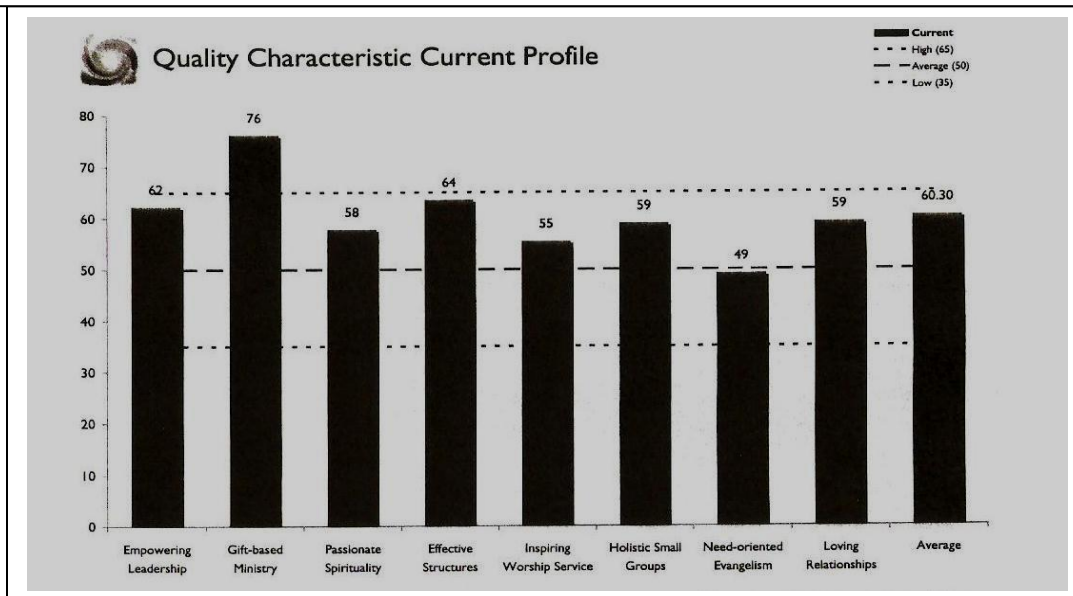
And from the Visioning process we have recognized our need to CARE.

Sunday, June 27th, 2010 at 11am. We will join together for coffee and muffins followed by prayer time.

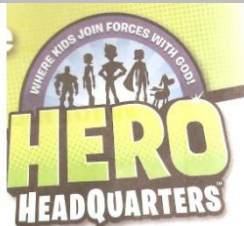
June Visitation
